

COVID-19 Vaccine in SLO County

SLO County Public Health is administering vaccine to all residents age 16 and older **by appointment only in:**
San Luis Obispo, Paso Robles, and Arroyo Grande

"Is the vaccine safe?"

Yes, the vaccine is safe and effective. You **cannot** get COVID-19 from the vaccine. Your arm might be sore after, but mild side effects like this are normal.

"Why should I get the vaccine?"

The vaccine will help protect you and your family from getting COVID-19. The vaccine can help our community return to normal life like going to school, church, gatherings and more.

"How much does the vaccine cost?"

The vaccine is available for free at County Public Health clinics— regardless of insurance, immigration status, or vaccine phase.

"How do I know if I am eligible for vaccine?"

All SLO County residents age 16 and older are now eligible to get the COVID-19 vaccine.

"How do I sign up for an appointment?"

Community members who are currently eligible for their vaccine can book their first and second dose vaccine appointments through the State's vaccine appointment scheduling system, My Turn.

"What documentation will I need?"

You will need to bring documentation of your age and current residency in SLO County. This can be your ID, a utility bill, tax bill, or mortgage or lease statement. **You do not need to show proof of United States citizenship, only SLO County residency.**
